Wikimedia versus Traditional Biographical Dictionaries?

Wikipedia has become the primary source of biographical information due to its extensive coverage. Traditional academic biographical dictionaries mostly serve to cross-verify or find entries not yet covered by Wikipedia.

However, a mutual dependence between Wikipedia and traditional biographical dictionaries is still evident, as Wikipedia and even more so Wikidata rely on authority data generated by traditional producers of dictionaries.

The aim of the conference is to discuss how the creation of traditional dictionaries and Wikipedia/Wikidata could complement each other.
